There are four performance levels: In Good Standing, Improvement Needed, Significant Improvement Needed and License Revoked.

We also completed a resident and family satisfaction survey late last fall and the results are also very positive overall and are similar to previous years.

The one area that showed a decrease in resident satisfaction related to food, specifically the variety of the menu and that mealtime was pleasurable. A focus group was held with many of the residents who completed the survey and an action plan was developed to address their concerns. Overall, families were very satisfied with the care that their resident receives.

The Wexford is just completing another project called LTC e-connect. E-Health is leading the integration of electronic health care systems across the Province including the electronic medical record. **We are going live on June 1st, 2018.** More information is available in the Home.

1919

March of 1919 the church was established by an Act of Incorporation in the Provincial Legislature. The first site for the church was the Erskine Presbyterian Church formerly at Elm and University Avenue.

1948

The property was expropriated for the Hospital for Sick Children.

1960

A new church was constructed at Blake and Grantbrook Avenue. 111 Maitland Avenue was the temporary home of the church until they could occupy the new building.

1966

Declining membership and financial pressures made the closing of the church inevitable. The church was sold and the assets of the congregation from the sale of the church were put into a trust, and the interest on these funds was distributed to charitable Christian purposes.

1972

The Brotherhood Foundation was formed with the purpose of building a nursing home or a similar project to help the aged.

1978

With additional fundraising and assistance from various levels of Government The Wexford Residence was established and opened. It was known as "The House that Love Built"

1995

The Wexford Residence was incorporated with its own Board of Directors assuming responsibility for management and operation of the facility.

Thank You

The Wexford is one of just 7 long-term homes awarded this designation this year. In total, there are now 21 homes in the Province participating in this initiative, out of over 600 long-term care homes. This is a 3 year commitment from 2018-2021.

Julia Beckford, our Staff Development Coordinator and Quality Improvement Facilitator, is the project lead. We will have a number of different champions participating and our first champion, **Pryanka Luthra, RN**, is the 2nd floor Charge Nurse.

Although this program is sponsored by the RNAO, it is a multi-disciplinary team that will be implementing the various projects. Over the next three years we will be implementing the following Best Practices Guidelines:

- 1) Preventing Falls and Reducing Harm from Falls
- 2) Oral Health.
- 3) Best Practice Guidelines Person and Family Centered Care.
