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Family Portals

The Life Enrichment Department is pleased to introduce the new 'family portal', a web-based program through which family members can review their loved ones participation rates in activities as well as communicate and post photos to each other. We believe this will add to the home's positive customer service experience by allowing you access to resident specific activity.

The family portal consists of 4 key elements which include (1) a Primary Calendar, (2) Family Comments and Photos,

(3) Monthly Attendance Summary and (4) Yearly Pie Chart.

(1) Primary Calendar:

- A calendar will populate using your family members preferred activities.
- You will have the option to subscribe to the calendar which will allow you to upload the calendar to your Microsoft Outlook calendar or phone.
- This will allow you to set reminders of events that your family would generally take part in e.g. Pub Night, Bingo and Special Events.
- You will also be able to view the general activity calendars from all units.
- Upload Pictures to share with your family
- Change your security options i.e. password and add other family users.
- Useful links will act as a direct link to Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care Website, Wexford Home Page and other health and recreation related web pages.

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FROM SANDY'S DESK



This fall we will install the **new hydro transformer** which supplies all the electricity to the home. This is necessary as the current transformer is the original one and it is now 35 years old and at the end of it's useful life. We expect to install the

transformer by the week of October 22nd (Wednesday October 24th is the tentative date).

We will have one day of power disruption however we will have emergency power for the 8 hour period. We expect to cut the power immediately after breakfast is prepared, around 8:00 am, and expect it to be up and running by 6:00 pm, at the latest. Lunch will be a hot meal but dinner that evening will be a cold plate. All meals will be served on the units as the elevator will be for emergency use only. We will bring in additional staff to ensure that everyone is well cared for and that safety standards are met.

Once the new transformer is in place, we will begin to decommission the old hydro vault. This will take six to eight weeks and will necessitate a reduction in available visitor parking, along the east side of the parking lot, near Gooderham Ave.

This entire project will be completed before the end of 2012.

The other project that we are working on is the **new gazebo for the back garden**. Between last year's Christmas fundraising campaign and June's successful golf tournament we have \$25,000 to spend on the gazebo. We have a small working group comprised of staff, tenants, residents and families who will assist in choosing the best design for this new space.

Once we have chosen the design, we will share it with you and plan for a spring implementation, so that the gazebo will be available for all to enjoy next year. Thanks to everyone for your generous support of this project. Once in place, it will enhance the back garden and be available for tenants, residents, staff and families to enjoy.

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(2) Family Comments and Photos:

- This is where you will be able to communicate with other members of your family.
- You will also receive notices in this area from the Life Enrichment Director on upcoming events or any cancelations and reminders in regards to activities.
- The photo link will allow you to upload pictures so that all members of your family will be able to view them. Eventually the Life Enrichment team will be able to upload photos as well.

(3) Monthly Attendance Summary:

- The Bar Graphs will give you, at a glance, the number of activities your loved one is participating in on a monthly basis.
- This will be color coded into the five domains:
- Physical
 Intellectual
 Emotional
- 4. Social
- 5. Spiritual




- The total number of activities in a month is located on the top of the chart.
- The attendance numbers will automatically update every hour.

(4) Yearly Pie Chart:

• This is a rolling 12 month pie chart that tracks your family member's trends in each domain so that you have a better understanding of what their interests are.

• Even if your family member has been here less than a year, it will update data for the amount of time they have been here, so this chart may change from the beginning of their stay at The Wexford to the current day.



The Portal is still at the beginning stages and there will be some issues that will need to be addressed as this system gets up and running. Family members will be encouraged to send feedback and suggestions so that we can continue to work with the software provider to improve the usefulness of the portal for all family members.

Over the next few weeks all POA's will be contacted and will be given the option to subscribe to the family portal. Any additional training will be provided by the Director of Life Enrichment, Wayne Connelly, by appointment. Recently the Foundation received 10 lovely park benches for the Home from the Eglinton Square


