

Things to remember:

- ◆ These instructions are subject to change.

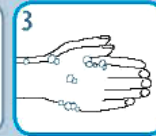
How to handwash



Wet hands with warm water.



Apply soap.



Lather soap & rub hands palm to palm

Lather hands for 15 seconds



Rub in between & around fingers.



Rub back of each hand with palm of other hand



Rub fingertips of each hand in opposite palm.

Lather hands for 15 seconds



Rub each thumb clasped in opposite hand.



Rinse thoroughly under running water.



Pat hands dry with paper towel.



Turn off water using paper towel.



Your hands are now safe.

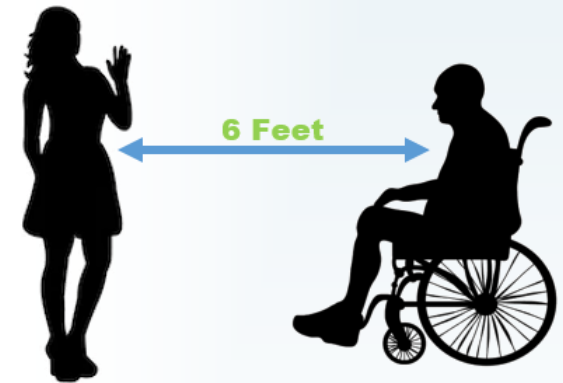
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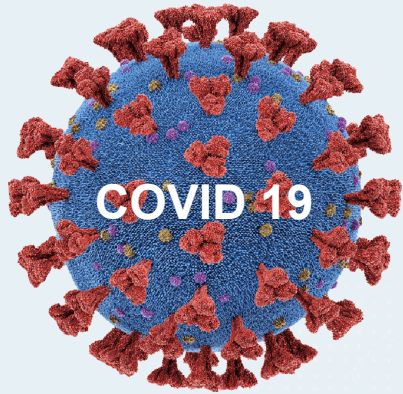
Visiting Your Loved One in the time of COVID-19

What to expect regarding your visit:

- ◆ Use the Visitor Registration Form on our website to schedule your visit.
- ◆ Bring a cloth mask with you for outdoor visits. Put it on before you enter the Home.
- ◆ For Indoor visits, you will be given a procedural mask to wear.
- ◆ Masks are to be worn for the duration of your visit.
- ◆ You will be screened at your visit. This will involve taking your temperature and answering questions. About your current state of health.
- ◆ Sign the Attestation that you had a negative nasal swab test and are currently symptom free. (for indoor visits)
- ◆ You will be asked to use hand sanitizer. Please follow directions given on proper technique. (steps 1-7 from How to hand wash - see back page)

- ◆ Respect the guidelines that have been put in place. Please ask if you do not understand them.
- ◆ Answer the screening questions honestly.
- ◆ Your visit is limited to your loved one only.
- ◆ Only two visitors per resident.
