- We talked about how important it is for family members to wear the badges that are being printed from the sign-in kiosk.
 - Next steps: we will meet with Wexford management to prepare a message about the importance of wearing the badges in the building.

Education Topics

- The virtual Palliative care education series being presented by Centres for Learning, Research and Innovation in Long-Term care are continuing. The schedule for the last presentation is on March 13 (at 1:00 to 2:30 p.m.) and the topic is “Caring for Yourself”.

- We are still planning to organize an information session with a local funeral home. There are only a small number of family members who are interested in attending (thank you to those who have already sent me the information about when they can attend). We have decided to also offer the opportunity to our tenants to attend.
The funeral home will discuss the importance of pre-planning as well what you will need to do when someone passes away. We will try to schedule this session when the most people can attend.
